

## Albany County Homeless Programs HMIS Annual Report

**Census:**

***Duplicated Count:*** 12,239 persons in 8,456 households, including 4,902 children in a total of 2,504 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.

***Unduplicated Count:*** 7,763 persons in 4,451 households, including 2,399 children in a total of 1,241 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.
