

**Columbia-Greene Homeless Programs HMIS Annual Report**

**Census:**

***Duplicated Count:*** 2,196 persons in 1,885 households, including 1,601 children in a total of 794 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.

***Unduplicated Count:*** 2,135 persons in 1,826 households, including 1,522 children in a total of 761 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.
