Census:

Duplicated Count: 3,116 persons in 1,818 households, including 1,154 children in a total of 615 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.

Unduplicated Count: 2,819 persons in 1,522 households, including 1,029 children in a total of 550 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.
