

**Schenectady County Homeless Programs HMIS Annual Report**

01/01/10-12/31/10

*Please note that, by law, providers of Domestic Violence services do NOT participate in the HMIS as per HUD regulations. These numbers represent consumers who are in the general homeless shelter and service population, seeking aid from participating agencies.*

**Census:**

***Duplicated Count:*** 3,462 persons in 2,335 households, including 1,736 children in a total of 830 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.

***Unduplicated Count:*** 3,163 persons in 2,054 households, including 1,635 children in a total of 765 families were reported in the HMIS during this time period.
